Well done Tracy! So much hard work and dedication!

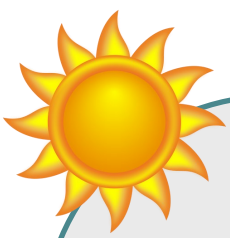
She has enthusiastically learnt different aspects of the shop and has got to know all of the staff there. She has become an asset to their team!



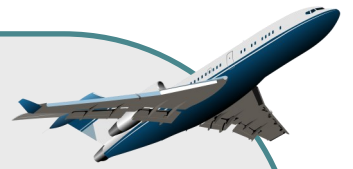

All the beautiful outdoors adventures that the Lake District has to offer were explored by another group.



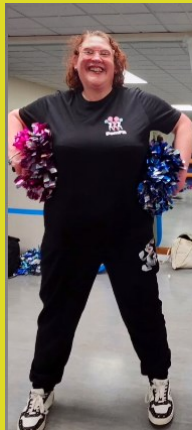
Finally— a very sunny Corfu was thoroughly enjoyed by David, Tracy, Jay, Lorraine & Jonathan!
