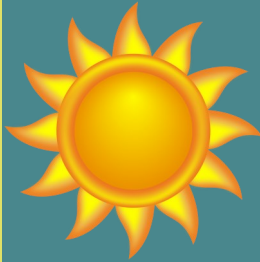

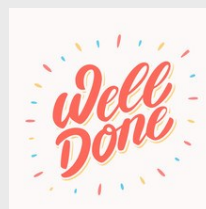

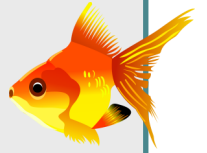




Holiday Season!
